


Target: I know the number bonds to 10


By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is to recall these facts instantly.

What can this look like?

$0 + 10 = 10$	$3 + 7 = 10$
$10 + 0 = 10$	$7 + 3 = 10$
$1 + 9 = 10$	$4 + 6 = 10$
$9 + 1 = 10$	$6 + 4 = 10$
$2 + 8 = 10$	$5 + 5 = 10$
$8 + 2 = 10$	

$0 + 10 = 10$ $10 + 0 = 10$ $10 - 10 = 0$ $10 - 0 = 10$	$1 + 9 = 10$ $9 + 1 = 10$ $10 - 1 = 9$ $10 - 9 = 1$	$2 + 8 = 10$ $8 + 2 = 10$ $10 - 2 = 8$ $10 - 8 = 2$
$3 + 7 = 10$ $7 + 3 = 10$ $10 - 3 = 7$ $10 - 7 = 3$	$4 + 6 = 10$ $6 + 4 = 10$ $10 - 4 = 6$ $10 - 6 = 4$	$5 + 5 = 10$ $10 - 5 = 5$

The children should be able to answer these questions in any order including missing number questions

KEY VOCABULARY

2 add 8 equals 10
 8 plus 2 is the same as 10
 10 take away 7 equals 3
 10 subtract 3 makes 7
 10 minus 9 equals 1
