Target: I know my number bonds to 100 using multiples of 5

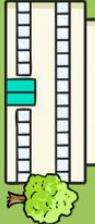
By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is to recall these facts instantly.

$5 + 95 = 100$	$55 + 45 = 100$
$10 + 90 = 100$	$60 + 40 = 100$
$15 + 85 = 100$	$65 + 35 = 100$
$20 + 80 = 100$	$70 + 30 = 100$
$25 + 75 = 100$	$75 + 25 = 100$
$30 + 70 = 100$	$80 + 20 = 100$
$35 + 65 = 100$	$85 + 15 = 100$
$40 + 60 = 100$	$90 + 10 = 100$
$45 + 55 = 100$	$95 + 5 = 100$
$50 + 50 = 100$	$100 + 0 = 100$

The children should be able to answer these questions in any order including missing number questions
