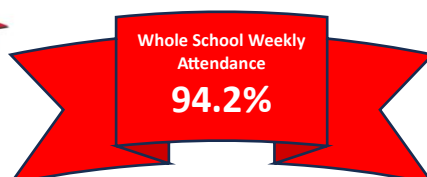
Have a wonderful Easter break and we will see you all on Monday April 8<sup>th</sup>.

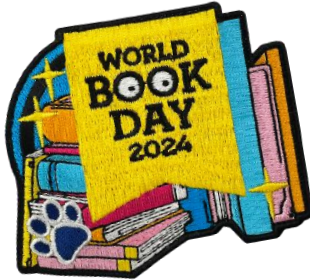
